	Tracheostomy Care Change Skills (circle one): Pass Needs Remediat	ion
Skill Step	Critical Performance Criteria	✓ if done correctly
1	Ensure adequate resources at minimum - two providers at bedside	
2	Standard Precautions at minimum - gloves, eye protection	
3	Assess A-B-Cs	
4	Properly position the patient	
5	Explain the procedure to the patient & family	
6	Apply oxygen as needed (02 mask or BVM if ventilator dependent)	
7	Gather and assemble needed supplies: Go Kit. If ALS, endotracheal tube	
8	Remove inner cannula, if appropriate, and replace with clean inner cannula; or	
	rinse cannula, reinsert, and reasses	
9	Use a syringe to deflate the cuff, if appropriate	
10	Loosen or cut tracheostomy ties	
11	Remove old tracheostomy tube, clean neck area quickly as needed	
12	Attempt to insert same size new tracheostomy tube, quickly remove the obturator,	
12	and maintain the tracheostomy tube at the neck	
13	Insert inner cannula, if appropriate	
14	Direct Provider #2 to attempt to ventilate through the new tracheostomy tube and	
	assesses for chest rise and fall, may listen for breath sounds	
15	Direct Provider #2 to inflate the cuff, if appropriate	
16	Direct Provider #2 to securely fasten tracheostomy tube with ties (leaving space	
	for one finger under tie)	
	If difficulty inserting the new tracheostomy tube, consider:	
17	- assist ventilations with BVM	
18	- reposition the patient, re-lubricates the new tracheostomy tube	
19	- request ALS, if BLS crew	
20	- consider consulting a Base Station	
21	 attempt to insert one-half size smaller tracheostomy tube 	
22	 attempt to insert new tracheostomy tube over a suction catheter 	
23	- if ALS, attempt to insert ET tube into stoma	
24	Transport patient and any equipment, EIF Form, etc to appropriate medical facility
