The Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems will make shoulder emblems available for purchase, for MARYLAND CERTIFIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PERSONNEL, to the limit of our ability to process requests. Shoulder emblems, to include cost of packaging and shipping are made available as follows:

Table with 3 columns: Item description, Price, and Qty Ord. Includes items like First Responder Emblem, EMD, EMT-A, EMT-B, EMT-P, CRT, and Replacement Certification ID Card.

COLLAR PINS

Table with 3 columns: Item description, Price, and Qty Ord. Includes All certification levels and MIEMSS Pin.

DECALS

Table with 3 columns: Item description, Price, and Qty Ord. Includes All certification levels, Reflection Decals, and MIEMSS Window Decals.

HATS

Table with 3 columns: Item description, Price, and Qty Ord. Includes Summer & Baseball and Emblem Coffee Mugs.

TRAVEL MUGS

Table with 3 columns: Item description, Price, and Qty Ord. Includes SHIRTS (Navy or Gray) and T-SHIRTS (Gray or Navy).

POCKET PROTOCOL

ALL orders must include 6% sales tax. Orders that are made by a tax-exempt organization to which the individual belongs must attach a tax exempt number and be on official organization stationary to include name, and identification number of the person(s) for who purchase is being made.

Payment by company check, cashier's check or money order payable to MIEMSS. We now take Master and Visa cards with a minimum of \$10.00 purchase.
