

Proposed Regulatory Change Regarding Requirements For
Provisional EMS Clinicians Seeking Full Certification or Licensure

The regulations establish requirements for obtaining a regular license or certificate by certain EMS clinicians who currently hold a provisional license or certificate issued under the executive order of the Governor to augment the EMS workforce in response to the COVID-19 health emergency. The EMS Board has requested emergency status for the regulation so that EMS clinicians who desire to move from provisional to full licensure or certification will be able to do so after the current emergency declaration has ended. Emergency status has been granted and the regulation is effect. The proposed regulation will be published in the June 19th issue of the Maryland Register.
