



# PPE Guidance Tool for EVD PUI

PPE	Exposure Level	
	No Bodily Fluids or Secretions Present	Bodily Fluids or Secretions Present
Foot Coverings	Single-use (disposable), fluid-resistant shoe covers (Stocked on Unit)	Single-use (disposable), fluid-resistant boot covers that <b>extend to at least mid-calf</b> (Readily Available Upon Request)
Gloves	Single-use (disposable) nitrile rubber examination gloves (Stocked on Unit)	Extended cuff gloves, 11 mm or thicker unsupported nitrile, neoprene, or other rubber glove without interior fabric or flocking. <b>Cuffs should measure a minimum of 11.5"</b> (Readily Available Upon Request)
Impermeable Gown	Single-use (disposable), fluid-resistant gown that extends to at least mid-calf, or coverall (Tyvek) without integrated hood (Stocked on Unit)	Single-use (disposable), fluid-resistant gown that extends to at least mid-calf or coverall (Tyvek) without integrated hood (Stocked on Unit)
Respiratory Protection	Surgical mask (disposable) or greater respirator (Stocked on Unit)	NIOSH-certified fit-tested single-use (disposable) N95 or greater respirator (Stocked on Unit)
Eye Protection	Splash rated, non-vented or indirect vented goggles that meet ANSI/ISEA Z87.1-2010* (Stocked on Unit)	Single-use (disposable) full face shield (Readily Available Upon Request)
Surgical Hood	Not Required	Single-use (disposable) hood that extends to the shoulders and fully covers the head and neck (Readily Available Upon Request)
Alcohol-Based Hand Sanitizer	√	√

\*Eye protection integrated with a surgical mask is not acceptable.
