International IV Fluid Shortages

Following the catastrophic damage associated with Hurricane Maria that hit Puerto Rico in September 2017, there has been a significant decrease in all forms of IV fluid (e.g. Lactated Ringers, Normal Saline, D5W) availability. This has led the Food and Drug Administration to reach out to Baxter and alternate pharmaceutical supply companies to try and meet the demand. This shortage has led to a rise in prices for IV fluids including Lactated Ringers. This shortage is likely to continue into May of 2018.

MIEMSS recommends that all EMS providers use saline locks for standard IV access and save the Lactated Ringers for severe traumatic resuscitation or required fluid challenges due to hypotension.
