- I. Call to order
  - a. Chair Eric Smothers welcomed everyone to the meeting and attendance was done for those in the room and online. The minutes from the April 5, 2018 were distributed electronically for review and to those in attendance. The minutes were approved as written.
- II. State Homeland Security Grant Project (SHSGP)
  - a. Review of Cecil County's FY 2016 SHSGP Grant
    - i. Region IV had a balance of \$20,277
    - ii. Waiting for approval to have two more classes and will be completed by mid-June
    - iii. The books have been purchased and received
    - iv. Monies will be used for supplies and equipment
    - v. After the purchase of the books, the balance to be spent between now and July 1st is \$19,722.
    - vi. Recommendation from the group is to pay what we allocated; reallocated the \$19,722 to the regions that have shovel-ready projects, but have to stay within in the grant and Region IV and Cecil Co is primary.
    - vii. The recommendation was moved to a motion and it was approved.
  - b. Applications for the shovel-ready projects has to be filled out and submitted. Conference call will be held next Wednesday, May 9<sup>th</sup>.

  - a. The matching grant formula was sent out to the group and will be discussed in next meeting in detail.
