- All EMRs will sunset on 9/30/2017 as their two years of NREMT eligibility to test will end.
- EMT: Select were given a six month extension.
 - 222 current number of SIPS
 - Several have entered another EMT Course
 - o 29 have passed
 - o 89 have exhausted their extension or attempts
 - All will sunset on 31 March 2018
