






PEMAC UPDATE – March 5, 2025
The CPS & OP Healthcare Project

- Held an interactive display on child passenger safety and occupant protection at the Winterfest EMS conference in Easton on Feb 1-2.
- Helped sponsor Dr. Janet Bahouth speaking at Winterfest Conference on crash mechanisms for bike, motorbike and ATVs.
- Participated in MIEMSS' recertification site visit of the Johns Hopkins Children's Center NICU on Feb 11th. Met with key staff and discussed their CPS activities and policies.
- In discussion with Hoopers Island VFD and Clear Spring Ambulance Club about each getting an all-in-one car seat for non-emergency use, and training on CPS and how to use the seat.
- Conducted an emailing to 300+ healthcare providers to share regional car seat check-up event schedules, updates to federal car seat standards as of June 2025, the new handout on non-compliant car seats, and the availability of CPS and OP materials from this project.
- Continued plans for a new webinar on pregnant women and their fetuses in motor vehicle crashes that will include recommendations for safely traveling in cars. "Bump Ahead: Ensuring Maternal and Fetal Safety on the Road" will occur on May 6, from 2-3pm. Promotional materials will be available soon. Continuing education for EMS, Maryland nurses and CPSTs is being requested.
- Continued to promote and distribute the new handout on booster seats and 11 x 17" poster, with deliveries to pediatricians' offices around the state.
- Continued to provide car seats for needy families. Receiving agencies are primarily mother-baby units in hospitals, but also EDs, NICUs and Safe Kids-Maryland partners.
- Submitted a proposal to the Maryland Highway Safety Office to fund this project for FY26 (October 1, 2025 - Sept 30, 2026)
- Prepared a presentation on CPS for Maryland healthcare agencies that will be given on March 11 at the national Lifesavers Traffic Safety Conference.
