# **EMSC & EMSC SP Grant Updates:**

- THANK YOU to all the EMS Agencies and EDs in Maryland!. In 2021 there were two EMSC national assessments (surveys) conducted with 100% participation from all Maryland EMSOP and EDs.
- 2. **C4 Pediatrics** launched on October 1, 2021 to provide 24/7 consultation and assistance with transferring pediatric patients to both acute and critical care beds.
- 3. **2022 EMS for Children EMS Survey** will launch on January 2, 2022. Orientation training will be offered in December and "Office Hours" online throughout the survey timeframe.
- 2022 Pediatric EMS & ED Champion quarterly forums and trainings are being scheduled.



Safe Kids Maryland Meetings: March 2, 2022 & September 7, 2022 following PEMAC. Buckle Up Grant – in person CPST & Update trainings started again in October 2021. Car Seat support for EMS agencies and ED is still available.

**Maryland CPS & OP** grant is providing continuing education for EMS & ED staff to reenter in person Car Seat assistance to families. 2021 Webinars are available on MIEMSS YouTube account. cps@miemss.org

**Bike Safety** grant is funded for 5<sup>th</sup> year, providing bike safety information and bike helmets through Safe Kids coalitions and community partners. <a href="mailto:bikesafety@miemss.org">bikesafety@miemss.org</a> **Infant Safe Sleep** displays are being developed to support the county and state CFR teams efforts to reduce infant suffocation.

- #MDPANDAFAN (EMSC Family Advisory Network Council): FAN chair Lisa Wilson piloted a Safe Sleep display at an open house in October. More displays are being developed this fall through EMSC SP grant funding.
- ➤ Risk Watch Injury Prevention –EMSC, Safe Kids MD and Risk Watch teams are working on creating virtual training modules and classrooms. Subcommittee will meet on 11/15/2021 @ 7:30 PM with the Fire Prevention committee virtual GoToMeeting platform.
- Child Passenger Safety Week in September included a variety of in person & virtual activities. CPS courses to start after October 1st. EMSC CPS grant has course scholarships available.
- ➤ Outdoor Temperature Displays –The displays are kept at MIEMSS, Cecil County DES, Prince George's County Fire & Rescue Association, and Meritus Medical Center/ Safe Kids Washington County.
