Re: Commercial ALS Vacancy on the Protocol Review Committee

MIEMSS seeks qualified nominees for the "Commercial ALS Clinician" representative on the Protocol Review Committee. The position has a four-year term from date of appointment. Six meetings are held per year at MIEMSS in Baltimore (2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of odd months) with a minimum required attendance of four meetings per year. Virtual meeting links are available for all in-person meetings.

Interested candidates should apply in writing to their respective Jurisdictional EMS Medical Director for consideration. Individual clinicians should <u>not</u> submit applications to MIEMSS directly. Applicants should provide information including but not limited to:

- 1. Length of time as an ALS clinician
- 2. Unique qualifications (training, instructor qualifications, supervisory positions, any committee service, etc.)

The advertisement period in the jurisdiction will be 30 calendar days from the time of this announcement. Once the advertisement period ends, all applications should be received. Jurisdictional EMS Medical Directors will have 21 calendar days to submit one name to the State EMS Medical Director for consideration (no later than January 5, 2026). MIEMSS will announce the new PRC member's appointment prior to the January 14, 2026 Protocol Review Committee meeting.
