FREDERICK, MD – The Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems, MIEMSS, celebrates EMS Week by honoring men and women across Maryland who have contributed to the EMS system. <u>The eight categories</u> for awards relate to specific incidents occurring from January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022. Of the 8 awards, The **MARYLAND STAR OF LIFE AWARD** is given to an individual, multiple individuals, or teams on the same incident for an outstanding rescue under extreme circumstances by EMS personnel.

MIEMSS will present its 2023 Maryland Star of Life Award to four Frederick-area emergency response agencies and personnel, including Urbana Volunteer Fire & Rescue, United Steam Fire Engine Company #3, the Frederick County Division of Fire and Rescue Services, and Maryland State Police Aviation Command, Trooper 1 for responding to a multiple car collision in the Northbound lanes of I-270. The collision resulted in a commercial dump truck overturned on the driver side, pinning the passenger. The incident necessitated a HAZMAT response to spilled fuel, extrication of the driver, and medevac transport to the R Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center in Baltimore.
